

## SUMMARY & PURPOSE

This site is the online version of the to-be-published nonpartisan reference book entitled **“9/11 Plus: Events Seemingly Related to 9/11 and Our Subsequent Invasion of Afghanistan and Iraq.”**

The work is a compilation of more than 6,000 sourced quotes from 1947 to date, from over 100 published books and other media, searchable in chronological or reverse chronological order.

The chronology contains key and important quotes from government officials, authors, journalists and others who were witness to the events leading to and following 9/11. Topics covered include Saddam Hussein and his involvement with our government, the rise of Osama bin Laden, the involvement of oil, what the top echelons of our government did and didn't do about terrorist threats prior to 9/11, our presence in Afghanistan and Iraq and examining the aftermath of our actions in these countries and America.

The purpose of this work is to:

1. Give the reader the tools to quickly and easily see who said what and did what when regarding the above related issues.
2. Illustrate the discrepant, contradictory, and at best, uninformed behavior of our government and others surrounding the worst tragedy of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.
3. Encourage others to think about and independently dig deeper into the issues explored in this work in the hope of generating more thought, research, and understanding of these topics, in addition to formulate better policies for our future.
4. Educate readers through a sourced historical perspective.
